

Readers Theater Option

Some groups that use this curriculum may prefer to spend less time on preparing the plays, and more time on the activities that teach the concepts presented in the plays.

These groups may prefer to utilize the plays in a Readers Theater format. This option would give each student a script, and students would be assigned specific roles in the play. Then, as a group (with scripts in hand), the play would be read aloud by the students. If there are more students than available roles, the other students could be assigned to be a character (puppet) in the play, and these students would move the puppets to the speaking parts.
